3. Income certificate (for the candidates claiming fee waiver) strictly according to format and duly signed by concerned authority not below the rank of Tahsildar, District Magistrate, Dy. Commissioner. **Certificate must be issued on or after 1st April 2017.**
4. 4 copies of recent passport size photographs. (Except for the candidates who already reported in NIT Nagaland reporting center)

How to Reach NIT Nagaland

By Air

Regular flights from Kolkata and Delhi are available to Dimapur Airport, which is located approximately 14 km away from the NIT Nagaland.

By Train

Dimapur is well connected to the different parts of India through a main line station of NorthEast Frontier Railway. The distance between the railway station and the Institute is about 18 km.

After arriving at Dimapur train station, an auto-rickshaw may be hired for NIT Nagaland Campus (fare approx. Rs.300-350/-). There are also passenger auto-rickshaws plying from Railway station to Chumukedima on the NH-29 @ Rs.40 per head. From Chumukedima you'll need to hire an auto-rickshaw normally at @ Rs.60/70 to reach NIT Campus.
