Indian Nationals who have passed the prescribed qualifying examination (B.Tech./B.E.) with **first class or 6.5 CGPA** for general candidates and **55% or 6.0 CGPA** for SC and ST candidates are eligible to appear for the 2nd Institutional Spot Round Admission 2026 at NIT Nagaland.

1. Candidates should not be allotted a seat in CCMT – 2026 National Spot Round Counseling.
2. Candidates who have taken admission through CCMT – 2026 process in any Institute and wish to participate in the 2nd Institutional Spot Round Admission at NIT Nagaland have to cancel their admission before appearing the spot round admission.
3. Non GATE Candidates also can apply, but candidates with valid GATE score will be given priority.
4. In case, result of qualifying degree is awaited, provisional admission will be permitted to a candidate subject to meeting above minimum academic requirements latest by August 30th 2026.
