The committee recommended that damage assessment in terms of cost be made by NIT Nagaland in consultation with Nagaland Public Works Department (NPWD) and state government revenue authorities. The Nagaland Police Engineering Project / Nagaland Public Works Department (NPWD) has submitted an estimate of Rs. 3.49 Crores plus additional 13% overhead charges (as prescribed by the Government of Nagaland for Depository works) over and above the estimates cost on rehabilitation, building up of retaining walls and filling up of the affected areas.
